The Origins of Brigadoon's Prison Program By Alli Engelke (Part 1 of 2)

Brigadoon is different than a lot of the other organizations out there that are breeding and training service dogs. What makes Brigadoon unique is that it gets its labor force from local prisons. Brigadoon service dogs are trained by prison inmates. For decades now, prison programs have been used to produce successful service dogs to their communities. What's great about prison dog training programs is that they often make a significant difference in the lives of the inmate trainers.

It was a Dominican nun, Sister Pauline Quinn, who first came up with the idea of using dog training programs in prisons. Sister Pauline had a rough upbringing before she decided to dedicate her life to service. She grew up in an abusive household, and eventually she ran away. As a young teen she was living on the streets of L.A. Not long after, she was picked up by the authorities. Unable to return home, she was placed into a series of institutions. When she was finally released as an adult, she went right back to living on the streets.

Things only started to turn around after Sister Pauline met Joni. Joni was a stray German Shepherd, and the sister adopted her to be her companion animal. The two formed a powerful bond. From their union, a new and beautiful movement began, for it was Joni who inspired Sister Pauline to start the first prison dog training program. In 1981, she formed the *Prison Pet Partnership* at the Washington State Correctional Center for Women in Gig Harbor, WA.

The program was designed at first simply to allow inmates to work with rescue animals and benefit from being around them. Later it grew to include the training of service animals for those in need. The Prison Pet Partnership continues to thrive today. Since its inception, it has placed over 700 dogs into new homes.

Full Circle

Dan was absolutely thrilled when he was asked to work as a Level III Dog Trainer at **Brigadoon**. Dan was a Stafford Creek inmate who served his full term. He was released five months ago. It was at Stafford that he first got involved with Brigadoon as a dog trainer. Now he has come full circle. **Brigadoon Barker** took a few moments to chat with Dan.

Brigadoon Barker: I understand you were in the military?

Dan: I was. I served two years in the Army National Guard, in communications, then I went onto United State Air Force active duty and I served six years as a Military Dog Handler.

Brigadoon Barker: What brings you to Brigadoon?

Dan: About fourteen years ago, I wasn't in a very good place in my life. I made some real poor choices and ended up incarcerated. I got sent to Stafford Creek as part of their veteran's program. They heard of my background and invited me to train dogs. I got to meet Denise. I learned positive reinforcement techniques, which was different than the military, and it absolutely changed my life.

Dan's dream after getting out was to become a professional dog trainer. He even wrote Denise about his plans four years ago. Now that dream has come true.
