



Released Dog Application to adopt a released Brigadoon Service Dog (BSD)

Before completing this application, be aware any dog adopted from BSD must be part of the family and sleep in the house. You are expected to feed the dog a high quality dog food.

If forever reason, you cannot keep the dog, you must contact BSD to offer first right of refusal. If you find someone you want to give the dog to, BSD must approve of the home the dog is to go to.

The standard adoption fee for young dogs is \$500. They are spayed or neutered and microchipped. They have some training.

If the dog is a young adult with advanced training the adoption fee will range from \$500 to \$1,000.

The application will only be kept for one year. You will need to apply each year if still interested. No out of state applicants.
